

Career Assessment Programs

Several Career Assessment Programs are available on-line to assist students in evaluating their interests, skills, and values. **It is recommended that you schedule a time to meet with a Career Advisor after taking the assessment.**

Focus (*evaluates interests, skills, and values and matches to careers*)

- 1) Go to <http://www.focuscareer.com>
- 2) Scroll down and fill in:
 - a. Username = your full GSU email address (Ex: first name_middle initial_last name @gasou.edu)
 - b. Password = birthday (mmddyy)
- 3) Read each page and click on “next” at the bottom of the page
- 4) Complete the first seven sections
- 5) Print all reports
- 6) Bring your reports to the Career Services’ Office to be interpreted by a Career Advisor

GCIS (*provides a skills assessments, graduate school and occupational information, and job outlook for Georgia*)

- 1) Go to <http://www.gcic.peachnet.edu>
- 2) If you are on campus, you do not need a password. If you are off-campus:
 - a. Username = gasoucs
 - b. Password = gcis598
- 3) Click on Enter GCIS
- 4) Click on SKILLS under Occupations and Employment
- 5) Select 5 very satisfying, 10 somewhat satisfying, and 20 moderately satisfying skills
- 6) Click on Rate Skills
- 7) Print the *Summary Skills, Holland Codes, Occupational Clusters, and Top 30 Occupations*
- 8) You may also view information about occupations and graduate schools in this program

Type-Focus (*evaluates preferences and matches to careers*)

- 1) Go to <http://careers.typefocus.com>
- 2) Click on New Users to register. Your site password = gsu7878.
- 3) Follow the initial screens to log-in
- 4) Answer the 66 questions in the personality profile. Go with your first instinct when answering the questions
- 5) Confirm your results
- 6) Click on Enter Type Focus Careers and follow the instructions to learn more about how your personality relates to careers.

Choices CT is an additional assessment program available on the computers in the Career Resource Center.
