

Recognition

To be recognized as a Greek-letter organization in good standing with the University, all social fraternities and sororities (chapters or provisional groups) must

- A. Be affiliated with a national organization.
- B. Remain in good standing with both the national organization and university.
- C. Have at least one active alumni advisor.
- D. Have a Georgia Southern University faculty member advising the chapter's scholarship program.
- E. Require that all members be current Georgia Southern University students in good standing with the University.
- F. Allow the Director of Greek Life to check each potential new member's, new member's, and member's GPA for eligibility and reporting purposes.
- G. Submit the following information to the Director of Greek Life within the first three (3) weeks of each semester:
 - a. Updated constitution and bylaws (if updated since the previous submission);
 - b. Officer and advisor list with contact information; and
 - c. Updated chapter membership roster.
- H. Submit the 5 Star Chapter Program documents to the Director of Greek Life within the requested time frame each fall semester.
- I. Comply with all student organization recognition requirements through the Office of Student Activities.

In order for groups to be recognized by the University, they must adhere to all standards, policies, and procedures set forth by the Office of Greek Life and Georgia Southern University. Failure to adhere to these standards may result in the organization's loss of University recognition.
