



Are your housing plans for Spring 2007 changing?

Are you Graduating? Student Teaching? Studying Abroad? or just taking a semester off? Current on-campus residents who will not be living on campus for the spring semester need to notify the housing office by November 1, 2006 that they will not be returning to the residence halls. If so, you must complete the following steps:

- (1) Complete the on-line cancellation at www.gsuhousing.com/cancel/. Does it matter when I cancel? Yes!
 - if you cancel by **Nov. 1**, you are eligible for the full refund of your \$300.00 security deposit.
 - if you cancel between **Nov. 2-Dec. 15**, you can receive \$150 of the \$300.00 security deposit.
 - if you cancel after **Dec. 15**, you will forfeit all of your \$300.00 security deposit.
- (2) Provide official documents of your involvement in one of the above programs to the Housing Office to complete your cancellation.
- (3) Check out of your residence hall with your RA and return your keys to avoid any improper check-out, cleaning, and/or lost key charges.
- (4) Your deposit will be refunded minus any charges for damages, lost keys, cleaning or improper check-out. If you do not owe any fees, the money will be issued back to you either by check (if you paid cash, check or money order) or a credit will be issued to the credit card the deposit was paid with. If you have any questions about your deposit once it shows up on your WINGS account, you may contact Student Fees at 912 681-0999.

Do you live in university housing and plan on not returning to Georgia Southern for spring 2007? If so, please complete the cancellation form at www.gsuhousing.com/cancel/. If you cancel housing and do not enroll at Georgia Southern University for the spring semester, you will forfeit your \$300 security deposit for failing to fulfill the terms and conditions of the housing contract. Students who withdraw after October 17, 2006 (Fall Semester) or March 16, 2007 (Spring Semester) are not eligible for any housing refunds of their semester rent.

Do you plan to move off campus but remain a student at Georgia Southern for spring semester? Students who wish to buy out of the Housing Contract may do so under the terms of the contract. Please refer to the contract at www.gsuhousing.com/contracts/ for specific information. All students who wish to buy out of their Housing Contract will forfeit the \$300.00 security deposit.

Please refer to your housing contract for information about canceling your housing contract:

Releases after occupancy date: After 9:00 a.m. August 11, 2006 if you want to cancel your housing contract and want to continue as a student at Georgia Southern, you will remain responsible for all housing fees through date of check out for the semester in which you cancel the contract, plus 50% of the remaining cost of the housing contract which ends on May 5, 2007.
