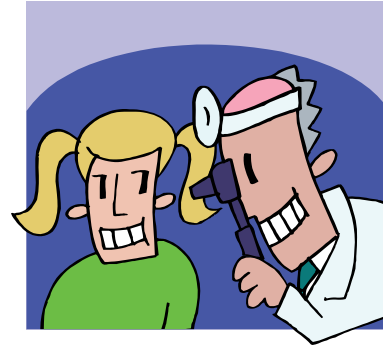

Sure, you can do whatever you want on your computer with a few clicks of a mouse, but don't you find that cumbersome at times? There's an easier way to perform common operations on your computer with a few key strokes on your keyboard. We've compiled a few for handy reference:

Shortcut Keys	Function
+S	Display or hide the Start menu.
+BREAK	Display the System Properties dialog box.
+D	Minimize all Windows and show the Desktop.
+E	Open <i>Windows Explorer</i> .
+F	Search for a file or folder.
+F+CTRL	Search for computers.
+F1	Display Windows 2000 Help.
+L	Lock the desktop.
+M	Minimize or restore all windows.
+R	Open the Run dialog box.
+TAB	Switch between open items.
+U	Open Utility Manager.
