



## Summer Housing



Are you taking summer classes? Do you need summer Housing? Housing for Summer Term 2008 will be located in Southern Courtyard. When applying for summer, you will need to follow the directions below. Students who are not current on-campus residents who apply for Summer Term Only will be required to pay the \$100 non-refundable housing application fee.

### How to Apply

1. Determine what style of housing (4 Bedroom or 2 Bedroom) that you wish to apply for and what term (A, B, A&B, or Long Term).
  - i. 2 bedroom Southern Courtyard – Long Term-- \$1111
  - ii. 2 bedroom Southern Courtyard – A Term -- \$625
  - iii. 2 bedroom Southern Courtyard – B Term -- \$573
  - iv. 4 bedroom Southern Courtyard – Long Term -- \$1044
  - v. 4 bedroom Southern Courtyard – A Term -- \$588
  - vi. 4 bedroom Southern courtyard – B Term -- \$539
  - vii. Activity Fee for A or B Term -- \$10
  - viii. Activity Fee for Long Term -- \$20
2. Once you determine where you want to live, go to [www.gsuhousing.com/summer08](http://www.gsuhousing.com/summer08) and complete the summer 2008 application. If you have a specific roommate preference, please specify that on the summer application.
3. If you currently live in Southern Courtyard, you will be assigned to your current space unless you notify us at [housing@georgiasouthern.edu](mailto:housing@georgiasouthern.edu) that you wish to be placed somewhere else. If you currently live in Southern Courtyard and have a fall 08 assignment, you may be placed in your fall 08 assignment if you are able to move to that space on Monday, May 12<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Otherwise, we can assign you to your current space and you will move at the end of summer. If you have a fall 08 assignment in Southern Courtyard and plan to attend long term or term A and B, we will assign you to your fall assignment if it is available.
4. Assignments for summer will take place March 25<sup>th</sup>-March 28<sup>th</sup>. We will then send out notification letters on March 31<sup>st</sup> and your summer 2008 contract will be due by April 14, 2008.

### What are the penalties for Cancellation?

1. You must notify University Housing of your cancellation by completing the online cancellation form at [www.gsuhousing.com/cancel](http://www.gsuhousing.com/cancel). Alerting the RA or other hall staff of your changed plans is not an acceptable form of notification.
2. If you cancel your summer application prior to signing your summer contract, there are no penalties for cancellation.
3. If you submit your signed housing contract for Summer and cancel after May 1<sup>st</sup> and you will not be enrolled at Georgia Southern, you will be subject to a \$100 cancellation fee. If your cancellation is received by May 1st, there is no cancellation fee.
4. If you submit your signed housing contract for Summer and are enrolled for classes, you are responsible for all terms and fees included in the housing contract.
