ROOM INSPECTIONS TO BEGIN

In an effort to better maintain satisfactory living conditions for student resident spaces, Residential Facilities (a department of University Housing) will begin inspecting all student rooms as a part of its overall maintenance and safety responsibilities.

Every student room, to include common living spaces (living rooms, kitchens and private baths, etc.) if applicable, will undergo a four step inspection once a semester to include the following:

1. Identification of maintenance needs
2. Identification of repair needs
3. Identification of cleaning needs
4. Inspection of life safety features such as, sprinkler systems, smoke detectors, evacuation maps, fire extinguishers, etc.

The inspection process will follow the following procedural steps:

- Each resident space will be inspected once per semester.
- Notification of inspection date will be posted for students one day prior to inspection. Notices will be slid underneath or taped to residence hall room doors.
- Inspections will take place between the hours of 10am and 4:30pm, Monday through Friday
- The inspector (a Housing employee) will follow proper room entry procedures and wear an approved name badge
- The length of inspection will average between 15 and 20 minutes
- Students do not need to be present at the inspection.
- A written report will be left inside of each resident space at the conclusion of inspection. A copy will also be forwarded to each Hall Director
- The inspection report will identify items noted for correction, along with items that are permitted for student’s self-correction. Students will be permitted three days to make any identified self-correction. You are encourage to review the form ASAP.
- Items identified as self-correction will be re-inspected on the third working day following the initial date of inspection.
- Any work not completed by students after the third day will be promptly addressed by maintenance and custodial staff. Needed repairs or cleaning services resulting from student’s non-response and/or neglect not previously identified on student’s room inventory form, will be billed back to each student. Students will receive an email indicating the charge has been posted to their student account.

Important Information about Your Housing Contract



Are you Graduating? Student Teaching? Studying Abroad? or just taking a semester off? Current on-campus residents who will not be living on campus for the spring semester need to notify the housing office by November 1, 2007, that they will not be returning to the residence halls. If so, you must complete the following steps:

- (1) Complete the on-line cancellation form at www.gsuhousing.com/cancel/. Does it matter when I cancel? Yes!
 - ⇒ if you cancel by **Nov. 1**, you are not assessed a housing contract cancellation fee.
 - ⇒ if you cancel between **Nov. 2-Dec. 1**, you will be assessed a \$100.00 contract cancellation fee.
 - ⇒ if you cancel from **December 2-the first day of the spring semester**, you will be assessed a \$200.00 cancellation fee.
- (2) Provide official documents of your involvement in one of the above programs to the Housing Office to complete your cancellation.
- (3) Check out of your residence hall with your RA and return your keys to avoid any improper check-out, cleaning, and/or lost key charges.

Do you currently live in university housing and plan on withdrawing from school mid-semester? If so, please complete the cancellation form at www.gsuhousing.com/cancel/. Students who withdraw after October 15, 2007 (Fall Semester) or March 15, 2008 (Spring Semester) are not eligible for any housing refunds of their semester housing fees.

Do you plan to move off campus but remain a student at Georgia Southern for spring semester? Students who wish to cancel their Housing Contract may do so under the terms of the contract. Please refer to the contract at www.gsuhousing.com/contracts/ for specific information.

If you cancel your housing contract and want to continue as a student at Georgia Southern, you will remain responsible for all housing fees for the semester in which you cancel the contract as well as the housing fees for spring 2008.
