Georgia Southern's Parents Association will be awarding academic scholarships to full-time first-year undergraduates who are students of Georgia Southern's Parents Association members.

Application deadline is Monday, August 3, 2009.

Applicants will be evaluated on high school scholastic achievement, questions and essay responses, and other relevant information as provided.

Award amounts are based on membership income and the number of qualified applicants. A minimum of \$250 will be awarded per semester to the scholarship recipients.

Requirements for Eligibility

- Applicant's parents or guardians must be members in good standing with the Georgia Southern Parents Association.
- Applicant must be an incoming new student in Fall 2009.
- Applicant must have a minimum High School GPA of 3.0 and SAT score of 1100 or College Transfer GPA of 3.0.
- Applicant must show academic achievement.
- Students must attend classes at Georgia Southern University during the semester(s) for which the scholarship is awarded.

Applicants must provide the information as requested in the application. Please take time to evaluate your credentials and select those for consideration that you feel are your most outstanding achievements.

Applications should be typewritten or computer generated.
