

## Accel Scholarship Program Tuition and Fee Payment for Fall 2009

Accel pays 100% of tuition for all courses that are approved by the Accel program. Mandatory fees are paid by Accel at the rate approved for the 2003-2004 academic year (\$350 for 4 hours or more). Students who take classes that are not approved by the Accel program must pay the cost(s) for those classes out of pocket.

Mandatory fees for the fall 2009 semester are \$722 for enrollment of 4 or more hours. Mandatory fees are as follows: Technology \$100, Health \$86, Activity \$98, RAC \$142, Athletic \$146, Transit \$50, and the Institution Fee of \$100. Students with 3 hours or fewer are charged only the Technology Fee and the Institution Fee. (Technology fee approved for 0304 was \$38)

The Accel “Book Allowance” is \$150 for 6 or more hours enrolled, and \$75 for 5 or fewer hours enrolled. The Accel book allowance is available as a credit in the GSU bookstore from July 29, 2009, until the close of business on August 25, 2009. Students may choose to use the book allowance to offset the mandatory fee balance not covered by the Accel Scholarship, by completing the authorization form in WINGS. If the student did not use the credit in the bookstore and all fees have been paid, a refund will be sent to the student’s direct deposit account or a refund check will be issued to the campus P.O. Box on Wednesday, September 2, 2009.
