**RECENTLY SEPARATED MILITARY SERVICE PERSONNEL WAIVER**

Any member of a uniformed military service in the United States who, within 12 months of separation from such service, enrolls in an academic program and demonstrates intent to become domiciled in Georgia is eligible for this out-of-state fee waiver. This waiver may also be granted to spouses and/or dependent children. This waiver may not be granted for more than one year.

**NOTE:** This waiver is for information purposes only and does not in any way imply a determination of legal residence in Georgia. You may be required to pay out-of-state fees if a decision has not been reached prior to the fee payment deadline to prevent cancellation of your classes. You will then be due a refund if you are determined eligible to receive this waiver.
