



Tuition Assistance: Reserve & Guard

Reservists and National Guard may be eligible for Tuition Assistance from your unit. This is not related to VA, but comes directly from your unit to cover tuition expenses. Get the forms from your unit, have them completed and turn them in to the office of student fees, Deal Hall, Ms. Diana McDaniel 6881-0999.

Georgia National Guard Service Cancelable Loan

GNG members must be in good academic standing and enrolled at least half time toward an associate or baccalaureate degree. You must submit a Georgia National Guard Service Cancelable Educational Loan application for EACH loan period you apply for assistance. See www.gsfc.org for further details.

Military Orders Tip

Locate former unit members who were listed on the same set of orders you received when you were promoted, transferred, deployed, etc. You could also use the Freedom of Information Act to acquire existing records of unit members whose record you are certain contain copies of orders listing your names.



Extended Licenses for Veterans

Veterans and their qualified survivors who maintain a GA driver's license will now receive an extended driver's license valid until age 65 and at no charge. Department of Driver Services began mailing renewal applications in June to those veterans w/ valid driver's licenses or ID cards. Complete and mail the application back to DDS. A replacement license will be mailed back reflecting the extended renewal period. The replacement license is valid until the 65th birthday.
