GSU HAZING POLICY

Georgia Southern University is unequivocally opposed to any activity by an organization or individual(s) within the organization that is herein defined as hazing.

Definition:

Hazing is any act which endangers the emotional, mental, or physical health or safety of a student, with or without their expressed permission, or which destroys or removes public or private property, for the purpose of initiation, admission into, affiliation with or as a condition for continued membership in a group or organization. Hazing includes acts that are intended to or actually cause physical discomfort, embarrassment and /or ridicule of another person for the purposes mentioned above or are violations of the Student Conduct Code.

Committing an Offense: The organization and any individual involved in hazing commit an offense by: engaging in hazing; soliciting, encouraging, aiding or directing another engaging in hazing; intentionally, recklessly or knowingly permitting hazing to occur; having first-hand knowledge that a specific hazing incident is being planned or has occurred and failing to report said knowledge in writing to any University Official.

Organization Hazing Offense: An organization commits an offense if the organization condones or encourages hazing or if an officer or any combination of members, pledges, or alumni of the organization commits or assists in the commission of hazing.

Consent: It is not a defense to prosecution of an offense that the person against whom the hazing was directed consented to or acquiesced in the hazing activity.

Penalties – University: Individual: Each individual committing an offense is subject to University penalties ranging from probation to expulsion.

Organization: Student organizations committing an offense may be placed on University probation to expulsion as well as withdrawal of University recognition.

Penalties – Criminal: Individual and/or organizations may be charged in criminal court as well as civil court due to allegations of hazing. Criminal and civil proceedings are separate processes from the University judicial process.

Officers and advisors names and contact information will be released to persons wishing to contact you unless you instruct us otherwise, in writing. Other information is for internal use ONLY and will be kept confidential.

By signing below we, the organization student leaders and advisor, certify that:

- This application is accurate and we will notify Student Activities of any change in this information.
- We have read and will comply with applicable university hazing policy and we will inform all other members and all prospective members of our organization of this policy.
- In consideration of the privilege of registering as a student organization on campus, our organization and its individual members agree to defend, indemnify and hold the University, its officers, employees and agents harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, expense (including attorney’s fees), or claims from injury or damages arising out of the activities or events sponsored or engaged in by our organization, but only in proportion to and to the extent such liability, loss, expense, attorney’s fees, or claims for injury or damages are caused by or result from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of our organization, its officers, agents, or members.
- No member of our organization will sign a contract on behalf of the University or act as an agent of the University.

We understand that as officers or designated student leaders, we may be held personally liable, collectively or individually, for any debts or obligations owed to the University by this organization. We hereby consent to having “holds” placed on our transcripts and/or registration materials should such action be deemed appropriate.
