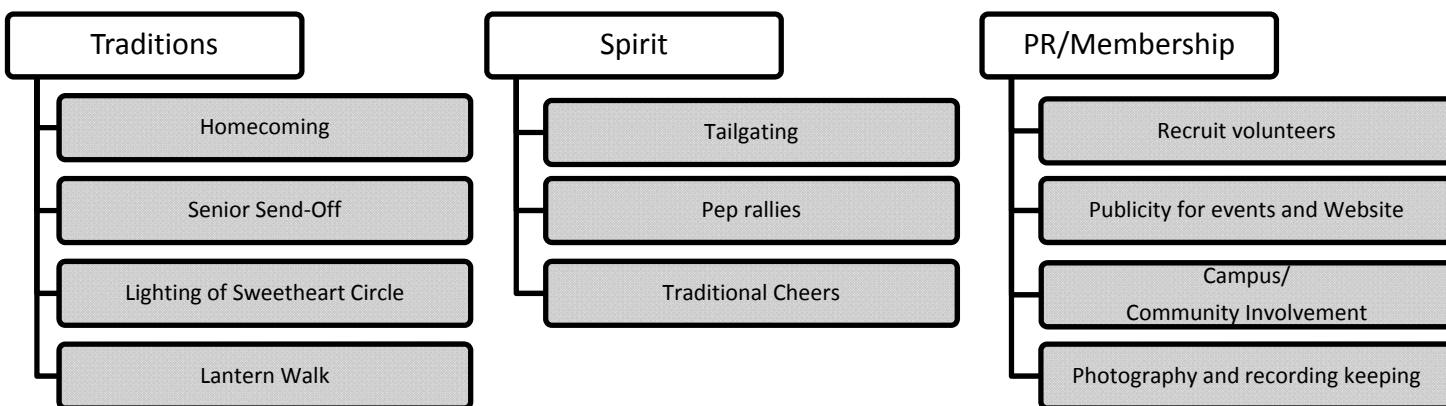




General Membership Application
